### STRATEGY: ONE-YEAR TO LEAD

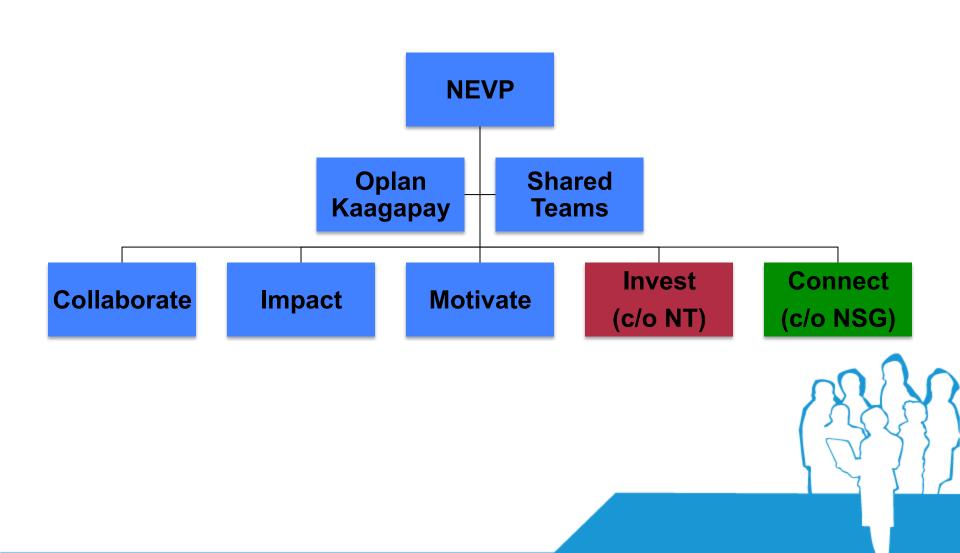
- Divide the year into 4 quarters
